MEETING OF THE 3 GROUPINGS OF UEMS SPECIALIST SECTIONS AND BOARDS

There are all medical sections distributed among 3 groups, our Section together with Anaesthesiology, Psychiatry, Neurophysiology, Dermatology and Venereology, Medical Biopathology, Nuclear medicine, Ophtalmology, Pathology, Public Health, Radiology, Radiotherapy. The discussion in all the groups underlined that recognizing the financial situation in the UEMS it is necessarily that transparency and information flow from Brussels to the Sections is obligatory to avoid misunderstandings.

UEMS COUNCIL – 1st part

The report of Secretary General stressed the importance of the opening of DME (Domus Medica Europea) and also moving of the UEMS staff to the new location. Financial matters became a problem related to the unexpected invoices of the refurbishment of DME. The Council approved the procedures that are needed to consolidate the situation.

The new UEMS Section in Clinical Pharmacology was created.

In the evening the official opening of the DME took place.

The UEMS is a partner in the EU Commission's new initiative to address the issue of healthcare workforce at the European level. We will take a part in this project.
