



Situation for Occupational Medicine

- Occupational Medicine is mentioned as such in the Annex to the Directive 2006/100
- It is recognized in 27 of the 28 Member States (the exception being Estonia)
- The minimal length for training mentioned is 4 years

- This internal Fund has helped to solve the cash flow problem

- Request from sthe Section of ORL to change the name into "ORL and Head and Neck Surgery"
 - Opposition of some Sections for instance Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery
 - Based on the Rules of Procedure, the names of the Sections should be the same as the name mentioned in Annex 5 of the EU Directive on PQR
 - It is only a recommendation but the UEMS Executive stresses that this has to be in accordance with the Annex as this is an objective reference

IMPROVMENT

- Each UEMS Bodies have now a dedicated bank accounts as part of the UEMS organisation.
- Reminder that all cash transaction needs to be processed through UEMS Bodies official bank account.
- It is fully illegal to hold a separate bank account (non UEMS bank acount)
- Flow of financial information needs to improve as email communication reveals to be not efficient enough (time consuming, overlooking information etc.)




2018 OBJECTIVES

- Improve the workflow between bodies and UEMS Office
- Keep uniform reporting and documentation among all bodies
- Keep history of all transactions (expenses, contributions) on-line
- Each bodiy deals with financial data using the same procedures and templates
- Build bespoke reports for the section while staying completely updated
- Standardizing the process will save time and ensure consistency.
- Financial information available on-line 24/7 for all.
