UEMS SG Dr. Bernard Maillet presented a report on UEMS Council Meeting in Brussels on 8th - 9th April 2011 and a review of the activities UEMS-EACCME-ECAMSQ (<u>file 3</u> attached). He exposed the situation on occupational medicine:

- Occupational Medicine is mentioned in the Annex to the Directive 2006/100
- It is recognized as a basic specialty in the 26 of the 27 Member States (only Estonia is missing)
- The minimal length for training mentioned is 4 years

Revision of the Directive on Mutual Recognition of Qualification for Occupational Medicine means also:

- Denomination of the Specialty
- Harmonization all over Europe
- Update of the content and length of training
- Introduction of "Particular Qualification"

The description of the Acronyms is also added to the Minutes (file 4 attached).
