- on April 24th in Eindhoven and
 on October 15th to 16th in Bucharest.

The most important goals we succeeded to achieve last year were as follow:

- creation formation of website: and our http://www.uemsoccupationalmedicine.com
- the acquisition of new members Italy, Slovakia, Hungary (the goal for 2011 is to attract our colleagues from Baltic countries),
- attractive discussions were presented on European Working Time Directive which is supposed to be a specific challenge for our specialty,
- a mode for Accreditation System for our specialty was created,
- information exchange and support of international projects relevant for the section (e.g. Modernet, ATOM),
- survey on National Societies of Occupational Medicine was carried out,
- information exchange on meetings of National Sections of occupational medicine,
- establishment of several working groups dealing with important topics:

- * Access to EU bodies, standards to advise EU policy makers;
- * Exchange of trainees among European countries.
